Meru-Sosian-Mara Itinerary

Day 1

Arrive into Nairobi, the capital of Kenya, in the evening where you are picked up at the airport and transported to a beautiful colonial-style, 4-star hotel for the evening.

Days 2 – 4

You are transported to Wilson Airport where you will board a brief charter flight to the Offbeat Meru Camp, located in Meru National Park, home of Elsa, the infamous lioness of “Born Free”. This is a truly magical park, bisected by 13 rivers and very few tourists. It is possible that you will not see another tourist the entire time you are visiting. Here in Meru, you will see lion, leopard, cheetah, elephant, black and white rhinos, giraffe, and many other types of gazelle and antelope. The camp has six large, semi-permanent tents, each with its own shower and flush toilet. These spacious tents are furnished with huge beds, solar lighting and the finest linens. The camp only sleeps a maximum of 12 and has a large dining tent, library, bar and a beautiful swimming pool. You will be able to participate in day and night game drives, walking safaris, bush breakfasts, and sundowners.



Days 5-7

You will board a charter flight for a brief flight to Sosian Ranch, located in the Laikipia District, near Mount Kenya. Here you will find a 24,000-acre privately held working ranch. The accommodations here are truly special. There is a beautifully appointed main lodge, along with seven double cottages. It has a swimming pool, billiards room, and tennis court. Here you may also participate in horseback riding, camel safaris, day and night game drives as well as visiting the beautiful waterfalls.



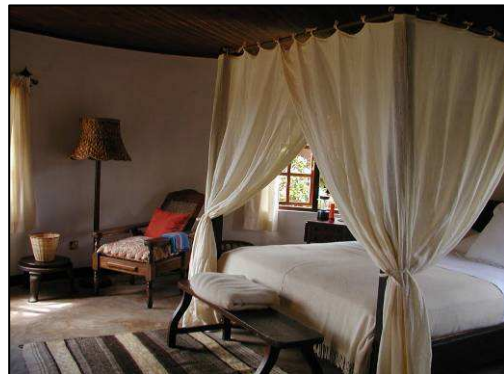
Sosian Ranch is a major elephant migration path and there have been herds of more than 300 elephant seen passing through the area. There are also several collared lion at the ranch, where they are studied and tracked for research into predatory behavior. The game spotting is spectacular here in this truly wild, unique place.

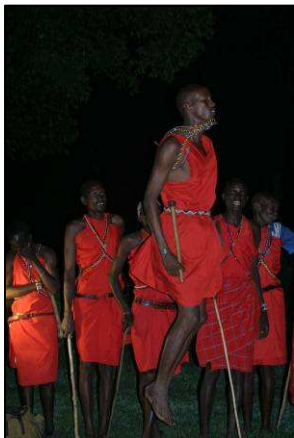

Days 8-10

You will depart from Sosian in the morning for a 45 minute flight to the world-famous Masai Mara. Here you will again find a luxuriously appointed semi-permanent tented camp, far from any other tourist destinations. The Mara has stunning views of its vast plains, along with amazing game viewing, including the annual wildebeest migration from July through September. You will participate in game drives, both day and night, along with walking safaris and visits to the local Masai villages where you will see how these amazing people live and thrive.



This camp sleeps a total of 12 guests in enormous beds covered with fine linens. Your laundry is done daily and even your shoes come back polished. You are treated each evening to gourmet meals including freshly baked rolls and breads. Late in the day you will depart for more game drives and “sundowners”, drinks on a hillside where you can watch the African sun as it disappears on the horizon. After dinner, enjoy “bush TV” as you gather around the campfire for conversation or just to listen to the sounds of lion calling in the night or hyenas on the hunt.



Day 11

Say “Kwaheri” (Goodbye) in the morning to the Masai Mara for your return to Nairobi. You will have a day room provided for you, where you will be able to freshen up before your late evening flight home. Before you leave Nairobi however, we suggest you visit the home of Karen Blixen, author of “Out of Africa”, after which we recommend that you visit some of the shops of Nairobi where you may wish to purchase some lovely carvings and other souvenirs.
