### **Tarangire – Katavi - Greystoke Itinerary**

#### **Day 1**

Arrive into Kilimanjaro International Airport in Arusha, a city of approximately 300,000 inhabitants located in the shadow of Mount Kilimanjaro. Your guide greets your evening flight at the airport and transports you to the Arusha Coffee Lodge – a beautiful, colonial-style, 4-star bed and breakfast for the evening.

#### **Days 2 – 4**

You are transported to the Arusha airstrip where you and your guide will fly to the Nomad Tarangire Camp to see some extraordinary game. This is a very exclusive, small camp with only 4 tents. It has incredible game viewing via Land Rover along with opportunities for walking safaris into some truly remote areas. Tarangire National Park is renowned for its large concentration of elephants, but you will also see wildebeests, zebra, eland, impala and many other animals. The Park is also known for some marvelous bird watching. You have the opportunity to participate in game drives, walking safaris, bush breakfasts and sundowners (“happy hour” in the bush).



## Days 5-8

You will board a chartered plane for a flight to Chada Katavi Camp, located in Katavi National Park, one of the wildest places on earth. Only 500 people visit this park annually. The camp is elevated on a peninsula which provides for breathtaking panoramic views of the Chada Plain. This is one of only three camps situated in this one million acre National Park that is teeming with game. The six guest tents, nestled in the shade of acacia and tamarind trees, are extraordinary. The large beds are complete with fine Egyptian cotton linens, and the floors are carpeted with thick woven rugs. Deluxe bathrooms adjoin at the back of each bed tent. You will be in awe of the contradiction between the luxury which greets you each evening in camp and the wildness of the surroundings.

Activities at Katavi include Land Rover game viewing, walking safaris and a night of fly camping. Fly camping offers a remarkable experience! You will snuggle down inside your cozy, comfortable bedding as you sleep in the bush with nothing between you and the dazzling African stars, except a mosquito net tent. The support staff is attentive to your every need, and the displays of food and drink while “roughing it” in the bush is nothing outside of amazing.



## Days 9-11

You will depart from Chada Katavi Camp in the morning for a flight to the legendary Greystoke Mahale camp. This is a true Garden of Eden with mountains rising to 8,000 feet above the cerulean waters of Lake Tanganyika. This is the second deepest lake in the world with breathtaking clarity and color. The camp is located on the edge of this extraordinary setting, with pristine white beaches surrounded by rainforest. The camp is located at the base of the Mahale Mountains, home to the world’s largest known population of chimpanzees. You will venture out each day to watch the troops of chimps as they play and forage within 15 feet of you. To be so near these magnificent creatures is a truly humbling and awe-inspiring experience.





After a morning spent observing the chimps, you will return to the camp to lounge on the beach or participate in some snorkeling and fishing. If you are fortunate, you may even catch some fish which will be served sashimi style right on an Arab dhow. Gourmet meals and fine wines lend themselves to glorious evenings in camp.

### **Day 12**

Leave the Greystoke Mahale camp to return via aircraft to Arusha for the afternoon. You will be provided with a day room as you prepare for your evening return flight to the States. There will be opportunity for shopping to purchase some world-famous Tanzanite, lovely carvings, or other souvenirs.
